
Ezekiel 18:4 (NIV): "The person that sins will die."

Exodus 20: 5-6 (NIV): "I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me, but showing love to a thousand *generations* of those who love Me and keep My commandments."

- 2. Gospel: Some Biblical Examples (From I John 4 [NIV])
  - v. 10 "This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son [Jesus] as an atoning sacrifice for our sins."
  - v. 19 "We love because He [Jesus] first loved us."
